



(CITY/TOWNSHIP NAME) RESIDENTS TO RECEIVE NOPEC ELECTRIC ENROLLMENT LETTERS

(City/Township) has joined NOPEC's electric aggregation program. As a resident or small business in a NOPEC member community, you can now take advantage of electric supply rates negotiated exclusively for NOPEC customers. All eligible electric accounts in your (city/township) will be enrolled into the aggregation program unless residents pro-actively choose to opt-out. Eligible customers will be receiving an enrollment letter that explains NOPEC's program options and rates, along with providing customers the option to opt-out of the aggregation program.

NOPEC is required by the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio (PUCO) to send these enrollment letters to all eligible electric residential and small business customers in NOPEC member communities.

To enroll, you do not need to take any action. Your account will automatically be enrolled into the Program Price Option. There will be no disruption of service during enrollment. To view NOPEC's electric rates, go to the Compare Rates section at nopec.org.

NOPEC buys electricity in bulk to help residents in member community's save on their electric supply. Residents' local electric utility will still be responsible for delivering electricity to homes and businesses, reading meters, sending bills and restoring power after an outage.

NOPEC also offers a variable rate program that is always a discounted rate below the Utility's Price to Compare. For more information on NOPEC's Variable Rate program or to enroll, call customer service at 855-667-3201 (855-NOPEC01). Enrollment in this program is limited and subject to availability.

If you would like to opt-out of NOPEC's electric program and choose your own supplier, fill out the opt-out post card included with your enrollment letter and return it by mail no later than (opt-out date).
