



## **(CITY/TOWNSHIP NAME) APPROVES NOPEC AGGREGATION PROGRAM FOR ELECTRIC**

(CITY/TOWNSHIP), Ohio – (City/Township) is now a member of NOPEC’s Electric Aggregation Program. Starting (Month, Year), (City/Township) residents and small businesses will begin to receive electric supply through the aggregation program. There will be no disruption of service during this switch. Residents’ local electric utility will still be responsible for delivering electricity to their homes and businesses, reading meters, sending bills and restoring power after an outage.

NOPEC (Northeast Ohio Public Energy Council) is a non-profit group of over 200 communities that negotiates lower utility rates on behalf of its nearly 900,000 customers. As Ohio’s largest energy aggregator, NOPEC buys gas and electricity in bulk to help lower customers’ utility bills. Since 2001, NOPEC has saved residents and businesses more than \$300 million.

Residents will receive enrollment letters from NOPEC detailing rate options prior to (Month). Those who wish to enroll do not need to take any action. As a resident in a NOPEC community, you will automatically be enrolled into the Program Price option, in which NOPEC negotiates exclusively for its customers.

All eligible electric accounts in your community are enrolled into the aggregation program unless residents pro-actively choose to opt-out. If you would like to opt-out of NOPEC’s electric program and choose your own supplier, fill out the opt-out post card included with your enrollment letter and return it by mail.
