

Diesel Mitigation Trust Fund (DMTF)

Summary: The Diesel Mitigation Trust Fund (DMTF) program supports the repower or replacement of medium- or heavy-duty diesel vehicles and equipment with new vehicles and equipment powered by clean diesel, alternative fuels (i.e., CNG, LNG, propane, diesel-electric hybrid), or all-electric vehicles and equipment.

Agency: Ohio Environmental Protection Agency

Eligibility: Proposals will only be accepted from the [26 priority counties](#) identified in the VW Beneficiary Mitigation Plan. Please see the Main\$pring Spotlight below for a list of eligible project types. For greater eligibility information, visit <https://bit.ly/2Jslu8h>.

Funding: A total of \$15 million is available for grant awards between \$50,000 and \$2 million per award.

Cost Match: A minimum 25% match will be required for all projects.

Deadline: Applications must be submitted online by August 3rd, 2018 at 3:00 PM EDT.
