

# FUNDING MAIN\$PRING PROGRAM

## FEMA Fire Prevention & Safety Grants

**Summary:** The FEMA Fire Prevention and Safety Grants support projects that enhance the safety of the public and firefighters from fire and related hazards. The primary goal is to reduce injury and prevent death among high-risk populations.

**Agency:** Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA)

**Eligibility:** All fire departments; and national, regional, state, local, federally recognized tribal, and non-profit organizations are eligible to apply.

**Funding:** A projected 150 awards are available with a maximum award of \$1.5 million.

**Cost Match:** A cost match of 5% is required.

**Deadline:** All applications are due December 21<sup>st</sup>, 2018 at 5:00 p.m.
