

Recreational Trails Program

Summary: The [Recreational Trails Program](#) (RTP) supports the rehabilitation, development, maintenance, and acquisition of recreational trails and related facilities. The trails may be motorized, non-motorized, or multiple use trails. RTP funds can also be used for environmental protection and safety education projects related to trails.

Agency: Ohio Department of Natural Resources

Eligibility: Cities and villages, counties, townships, special districts, state and federal agencies, and nonprofit organizations are eligible

Funding: The maximum award through the Recreational Trails Program is \$150,000 per entity.

Cost Match: A cost match of 20% is required.

Deadline: Applications must be postmarked by February 1st, 2019.
