

## Ohio Emergency Medical Services Grant

**Summary:** [The Ohio Emergency Medical Services Grant Program](#) provides awards to emergency medical service organizations for the training of personnel, for the purchase of equipment and vehicles, and to improve the availability, accessibility, and quality of emergency medical services in the state. Priority is given to grants that fund training and equipping of emergency medical service personnel.

**Agency:** Ohio Department of Public Safety, Ohio Emergency Medical Services (EMS)

**Eligibility:** All EMS organizations with the main responsibility of providing continuous service to the community pursuant to requests and/or calls from the public for EMS response.

**Funding:** The average award in the previous grant cycle was \$4,402.56, with the award range spanning from \$1,200 to \$9,379. Funds will be reimbursed within 30-45 days throughout the grant cycle.

**Cost Match:** No cost match is required.

**Deadline:** Applications are due by April 1<sup>st</sup> and must be submitted through the online EMS Grants Management System.
