

Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant Program for Law Enforcement

- Summary:** Supports projects that reduce crime, increase public safety, and support the Ohio Incident-Based Reporting System (OIBRS)
- Agency:** Ohio Department of Public Safety--Office of Criminal Justice Services
- Eligibility:** Law enforcement agencies not eligible for direct federal funding
- Funding:** Projects may receive a maximum of \$20,000 in program funds
- Cost Match:** A 10% local match is required for projects
- Deadline:** October 31, 2020

Eligible Funding Areas:

- Hiring, training, and employing on a continual basis, new, additional law enforcement officers and necessary support personnel
- Paying overtime to employed law enforcement officers and necessary support personnel for the purpose of increasing the number of hours worked by such personnel
- Procuring equipment, computer technology, and other materials directly related to law enforcement function
