- Eligibility:** Government entities and certain private non-profit organizations
- Funding:** Dependent on project scope and eligibility
- Cost Match:** None
- Deadline:** No deadline

- Emergency Operation Center costs
- Disinfection of eligible public facilities
- Communications of general health and safety information
- Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)
- Temporary medical facilities and/or enhanced medical/hospital capacity
- Use of specialized medical equipment
- Medical sheltering
