

## **Brownfield Remediation Program**

- Summary:** For the remediation of brownfield sites throughout Ohio, to assist in the remediation of hazardous substances or petroleum at an industrial, commercial, or institutional property.
- Agency:** Ohio Department of Development
- Eligibility:** Units of local government, county land banks, nonprofit organizations, and organizations for-profit are eligible.
- Funding:** \$350,000,000 available (\$1 million set-aside per county)
- Cost Match:** 25% match is required for projects awarded outside of the county's dedicated portion.
- Deadline:** Application deadline is January 31, 2022.

## MAIN\$PRING SPOTLIGHT

### Eligible Costs

- Any action to contain, remove, or dispose of hazardous substances at a brownfield
- The acquisition (limited to 10% of the total request, not to exceed the county auditor property value) of a brownfield
- Demolition performed at a brownfield
- Installation or upgrade of the minimum amount of infrastructure that is necessary to make a brownfield operational for economic development activity
- Property assessment and/or an asbestos survey for an asbestos abatement
