

FY 2022 School Violence Prevention Program

- Summary:** The goal of the School Violence Prevention Program (SVPP) is to improve security at schools and on school grounds through the implementation of evidence-based school safety programs and technology.
- Agency:** Community Oriented Policing Services (Department of Justice)
- Eligibility:** Local and state law enforcement agencies, counties, cities, and school districts, and public government agencies are eligible
- Funding:** \$53,000,000 available
- Cost Match:** A minimum 25 percent local cash match (cost share) is required unless a waiver is approved
- Deadline:** Application deadline is June 14, 2022

Funding Focus Areas

- Coordination with local law enforcement
- Training for local law enforcement officers to prevent school violence against others and self
- Placement and use of metal detectors, locks, lighting, and other deterrent measures
- Acquisition and installation of technology for expedited notification of local law enforcement during an emergency
- Funding of civilian personnel to serve as coordinators with local law enforcement
