Funding: Planning \$1,000,000 / Implementation \$30,000,000

Cost Match: 20 percent

Deadline: Application deadline is September 15, 2022

Project Categories

Action Plan Grants: Develops a holistic, well-defined strategy to prevent roadway fatalities and serious injuries in a locality, Tribe, or region.

Implementation Grants: Funds projects and strategies identified in an Action Plan that address roadway safety problems. Also, funds associated planning and design and supplemental Action Plan activities in support of an existing Action Plan.

Successful grant applications will demonstrate engagement with a variety of public and private stakeholders and seek to adopt innovative technologies and strategies to: Promote safety; Employ low-cost, high-impact strategies that can improve safety over a wider geographic area; Ensure equitable investment in the safety needs of underserved communities, which includes both underserved urban and rural communities; Incorporate evidence-based projects and strategies; and Align with the Department's mission and with priorities such as equity, climate and sustainability, quality job creation, and economic strength and global competitiveness.
