- Summary:** Available funding for non-profit organizations to develop and produce deeply researched, engaging, and immersive projects that appeal to a large audience of Ohioans.
- Agency:** Ohio Humanities
- Eligibility:** Nonprofit organizations located in the state of Ohio
- Funding:** Up to \$20,000
- Cost Match:** None
- Deadline:** Rolling February 15, June 1, and October 1 (Preliminary applications are due one month prior to the final due date)

Programs funded by the Ignite grant should make humanities content accessible to Ohio's diverse audiences exploring cultural and historical topics that will resonate with Ohioans, particularly projects that share Ohio's under-told, yet significant stories are encouraged. - Exhibitions and installations
- Discussion programs
- Oral history projects
- Documentary filmmaking
